


Figure 5a. Visual: Relationship between solfege ladder and pitch names.




Figure 4c. Visual and Organization: Lesson plan or game directions reside on the page and can be pulled out.




Figure 2. Worksheet: Sing, Move, Draw, Screencast.

Melodic contour is the way the melody goes. In your group create movement to describe the melodic contour of this song. Can you draw the melodic contour of the song.




Figure 3b. Visual and Manipulative: Moveable do, sol-mi line to line, space to space relationship, sing and play.




Figure 4. Xylophone Visuals. Interactive Xylophones.




Figure 5a. 2 Beat Flashcards




Figure 6. Rashaad's Rain Story Screencast






Figure 9. Seesaw


